

## Message from our Session Moderator

Dear Friends:

It is always difficult in the life of a congregation when a pastor leaves for something new. There is a hole in our hearts and a hole in how we do ministry. This transitional time is an opportunity for the congregation, to discern what comes next and to make an investment in the ministry of the congregation. Pastors come and go, and with them their particular ministry styles. However, when the congregation works together on a model of ministry that is driven by its members, then life as we know it continues, even during pastoral changes.

The presbytery's ministry team for Congregational and Pastoral Care (CPC) has named Dianne Larson, from Spirit Lake, as the congregation's liaison. Currently, Ruth Clendenin, pastor in Aberdeen, is serving as Moderator of Session. It is our hope to help guide the process of discernment to help the session and congregation to discover what comes next in the life of the congregation. Our work is about helping you find your way; our work is NOT to tell you how things should be done.

Currently, we plan to meet on Saturday, January 14<sup>th</sup> with both the Session and the Board of Deacons to work on some nuts and bolts to ensure that pastoral duties and leadership matters are not overlooked. FPC already has strong and gifted leaders on the Session and Deacons and a lot of dedicated volunteers that support the mission and ministry here in Brookings.

As Session Moderator, I am available via phone, text, or email for any questions or resource support you may need (806-893-4261 or <u>clendeninruth@gmail.com</u>). Dianne Larson is also available for support and encouragement (<u>dianne@ingallshomestead.com</u>). Please do not hesitate to reach out to us.

Effective January 1, 2023, the Session has voted to adjust the Church Office hours. The office will be open from 9:00AM until 12:00 noon, Monday through Thursday. At her request, Session also approved adjusting Rozanne McGrath's hours: Rozanne will be in the Church Office Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays from 9:00AM until 2:30PM; on Wednesdays, a volunteer will staff the office from 9:00AM until 12:00 noon. At noon, the doors will be locked to preserve a relatively uninterrupted block of time for Rozanne to concentrate on her work.

Please know that the presbytery is here to support your work in ministry, and we will journey with you during this time of transition. As Jesus said to his disciples, "Do not let your hearts be anxious, and do not let them be afraid" (John 14:27).
